DISCIPLINE ISSUES	
CONDUCT TEAM MEETINGS	 COLLECT CONSENT FOR FUNCTIONAL BEHAVIOR ASSESSMENT (FBA) if not already available. Collect data for 4-6 weeks, intervention. DEVELOP A BEHAVIOR INTERVENTION PLAN (BIP) if not already available. If available, revise current BIP. CONSIDER INCREASE OF SERVICE TIME to address issues.
ISSUES CONTINUE	 TEAM MEETING Revisit IEP Revisit BIP Increase of service time to address issues
ISSUES CONTINUE	 TEAM MEETING Revisit IEP Modify BIP Change of schedule or teacher Increase of service time to address issues
ISSUES CONTINUE	 TEAM MEETING Revisit IEP Modify BIP Increase of service time to address issues to maximum time for direct EC support (must consider school time)
ISSUES CONTINUE	 TEAM MEETING Revisit IEP Modify BIP Consider shortening length of school day to a modified day
ISSUES CONTINUE	TEAM MEETING Revisit IEP, consider homebound placement and contact EC Director **If the team decides HB placement is appropriate the case manager will review at least 30 days to assess progress and develop a plan to transition the student back to school. Students cannot be left on HB indefinitely.

ALL MEETINGS SHOULD BE CONDUCTED AND DOCUMENTED AS OFFICIAL IEP TEAM MEETINGS.
